Respected Mr. Belkić, Mr. Lozančić and Mr. Živković,

On 17th, December 2008. we delivered to the members of the House of Representatives of PA of Bosnia and Herzegovina and delegates in the Home of Peoples of PA of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the letter received by this Association on 22nd, October 2008 from Secretary General Mr. Terry Davis and the letter, received on 9th October 2008. from Director General for European Committee Enlargement Mr. Dirk Lang, under the appeal of Mr. Barosso.

We delivered the above mentioned letters to the members of Parliament of Bosnia and Herzegovina, because the most highly positioned functionaries of the Council of Europe and European Committee have supported the solving of the old foreign currency savings problem, emphasizing the responsibilities of Bosnia and Herzegovina towards its citizens.

On 13th, January 2009., the Board of the House of Representatives, constituted by you, informed this association that you got acquainted with our letter on your 81th sitting but you left us deprived of the information whether our letter was delivered to all the members of Parliament, as it was addressed to, or did you, as a Board, retain the content of our letters among the three of you, which was not our goal.

Regardless to your practice, this association probably would not have reacted if you had not written the next phrase at the end of your letter: "We remark that Bosnia and Herzegovina has the Law on Regulation the Liabilities on the Basis of Foreign Currency Savings of Citizens and as such, it needs to be implemented".

Respected gentlemen, we were shocked on the basis of this phrase.

Problems of the owners of old foreign currency savings are held in the fact that during the last 18 years they can not dispose with their property. It is completely irrelevant whether that Law exists or not, whether they have or have not verified their savings, whether they accept or not your charming – magical law. The owners of the old foreign currency savings do not have the access to their money, their property. Their suffering and pain are the only invariable constant. Gentlemen Belkić, Lozančić and Živković, you are experienced politicians and you have respectable experience in legislative body which makes our disappointment even greater regarding your dilettante practice, unless, some other intentions are being concerned or you operate under the government of those who, during the period marked by our suffering, got enormously rich and are still getting.

Respected gentlemen, were you of the opinion that your letter is sufficient to pacify all those who, through their decent work, have earned and saved three billion KM? Were you of the opinion that it is sufficient to mention the existence of the Law, not taking into account whether the Law is implemented and the results of the same? Do you intend to call for the foreign currency savings refund progress report someday? "Your Law" brings contentment only to those who invest their money, acquired through crime and corruption, into criminal affairs with foreign currency savings. You have not requested any data regarding the crime investigation in APIF agencies.

You will be informed about all the mentioned things by the European Court of Human Rights, but our sorrow and pain with you exceeds the justice that will come from Strasbourg.

Therefore, respected gentlemen, seize the power that was given to you on election, rectify the errors, do not support the preceding ones and avoid becoming the new creators of our sorrow. The solution exists and the history is written on the cheeks of the ones who govern as well. Think about our sorrow before you go to sleep tonight and see whether you will be able to sleep well.
