CONCLUSION

1. The Assembly adopts the proposal to send a Request to the Assembly and Government of the BiH Federation and Brcko District by the Association of Citizens for Return of Old Foreign Currency Savings in Bosnia and Herzegovina and Diaspora, Ivana Gorana Kovacica 139 b, to deliver entire documentation including names and surnames related to purchase of state capital using the old foreign currency savings, including flats, business offices, buildings, city construction land, agricultural land and other property which was in social ie. state ownership.
The Association obtained that kind of data by the Republic of Srpska (which show that there were many misuses of the old foreign currency savings and old foreign currency savers in the process of privatization of state capital).
2. The Managing Board suggests the Assembly to adopt the Conclusion that we will all together block the Slovenian and Serbian property, including their banks that work on the territory of BiH as well as the highest institutions of BiH if the accounts of old foreign currency savings do not get unblocked urgently and unless the payments start on the basis of the accounts of the old foreign currency savings of Ljubljanska banka dd Ljubljana and Investbanka Belgrade.
3. The Association requested of the Interdepartmental Committee of the Council of Ministers of Bosnia and Herzegovina which is in charge of this process to schedule a meeting urgently with the obligation to secure at the meeting the presence to the delegation of the Association of Citizens for Return of Old Foreign Currency Savings in Bosnia and Herzegovina and Diaspora led by the President Mr. Svetozar Nisic for the purpose of resolution of the process. Since the deadline for the final agreement was March of 2010 in Sarajevo, it cannot be expected of us to be patient any more (after 15 years have passed since the end of



the war, after we have become poor, ill, many are not alive any more because instead of enjoying their savings, they went to graves before their time because they were sad that their savings were taken away from them).

4. The Assembly adopts the conclusion on the proposal of the Managing Board of the Association of Citizens for Return of Old Foreign Currency Savings in Bosnia and Herzegovina and Diaspora: to resolve urgently the matter of foreign currency savings of Bosnian banks in which the citizens deposited their foreign currency deposits, which are Jugobanka and PBS, and in the meantime it needs to be enabled that foreign currency savers can pay all the obligations towards the state from the accounts of the old foreign currency savings, such as: health services, hospital and spa treatments, orthopedic aids, electricity, television subscription fee, court fees, construction licenses, all kinds of taxes until the return of all claimed money.
5. The Assembly adopted the proposal to send a Request with an attached letter of protest to the Attorney's Office of Bosnia and Herzegovina whose representatives on 10th March 2009 before the European Court of Human Rights in Strasbourg gave incorrect statements that in Bosnia and Herzegovina, foreign currency savers were offered the option of purchase of state capital with old foreign currency savings such as: flats, business facilities, buildings, companies, city construction land, agricultural land, construction material, and this is stated in the judgment. The Amendment by which the savers wanted exactly that was not adopted in the House of Peoples of the Parliament of Bosnia and Herzegovina, which is a proof that the attorney deceived the Court in Strasbourg with untruths.
6. The Association requests that we are delivered the list of all property which has been bought with old foreign currency savings and the names of the persons which purchased it, how much it cost, from whose foreign currency account, and on the basis of which legal regulations, because in the Act on Return of Old Foreign Currency Savings of Bosnia and Herzegovina there is no Article which enables that, and that is why we acted with an Amendment.
7. We demand that we have the right to purchase with the old foreign currency savings of all that was represented in the Court, under the conditions under which the mentioned purchase was carried out.
